Go Take A Hike! Woodland Interpretive Trail

Woodland Trail is a self-guided 1.5-mile interpretive loop trail where you learn about the botany, geology and wildlife of this woodland area. This unique nature trail with 16 numbered posts is considered easy, mostly flat with some short ups and downs. It takes 45 minutes to an hour to hike the trail. An Adventure Pass is required for use of the trailhead parking area.
