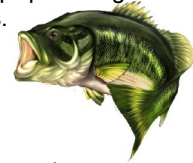
Aaron's Big Bear Big Bass Tournament

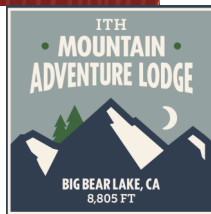
